#### Kathakali Theatre Workshop

Our Year 12 Social Anthropology and Theatre students took part in a Kathakali theatre workshop with leading Kathakali experts actor Kalamandalam Vijayakumar and make-up expert Kalamandalam Barbara Vijayakumar, from the Kala Chethena Kathakali Company.

The students practically explored Kathakali Mudras, the sign language of this ancient performance practice, before then watching a performance, allowing them to see the make-up, costume, music, movement and mudras all working in synthesis.
