We have a few staff moving on at the end of term. Dr Purday is relocating to South Africa after nearly 15 years at the College. The legacy he leaves of Social Anthropology at IB (one of the few schools in the world that offer the subject) and IB Psychology which he introduced at the College, is a remarkable one. Ms Danac (Languages) is moving to a new teaching position in South London, Mrs Winship (Careers and university guidance) is taking up a new role in outreach and widening participation for the Cambridge University English department, Mr Irish (boarding) has a new post in a boarding school in Wiltshire, and Ms Tudor (Maths) will be teaching in another local school. These staff have in some case been replaced by existing part-time staff taking on additional commitments and in others with new appointments. For example, for Careers and university guidance we will be welcoming Mr James Lee in January who has an excellent background in this work from schools in the UK and overseas. In Maths we will be welcoming Mr Donal McDougall who has a strong background in IB Maths teaching in the UK and abroad.

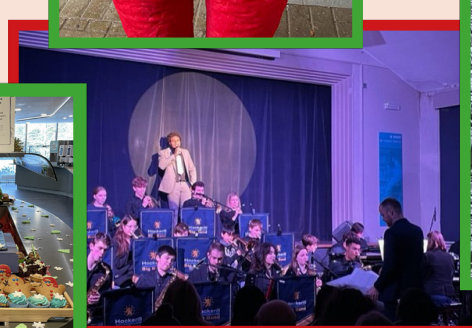
