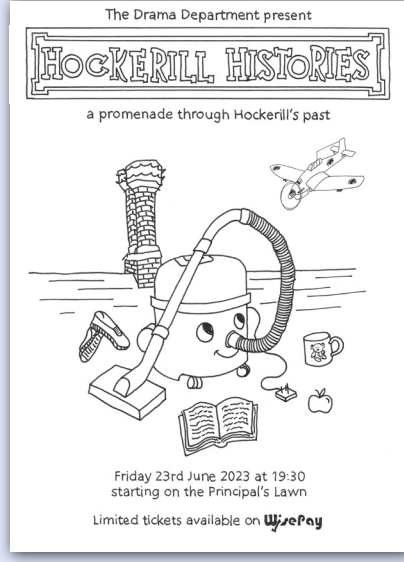

The students had many new experiences on the trip. The sun was shining all week and therefore students were able to take part in activities such as paddleboarding, swimming in lakes and rivers, barbeques, circus visits, enjoying the beautiful beaches of Northern Germany, and exploring the many sights of Hamburg. We started the trip with a walking tour of the beautiful city of Lübeck and viewed Lübeck and the surrounding area, all the way to the coastline, from the highest point of the city.

We spent two days at school, experiencing lessons at Johanneum Gymnasium. We also visited Hamburg to take a boat trip along the Elbe and visit Miniaturwunderland, voted the best museum in Germany. 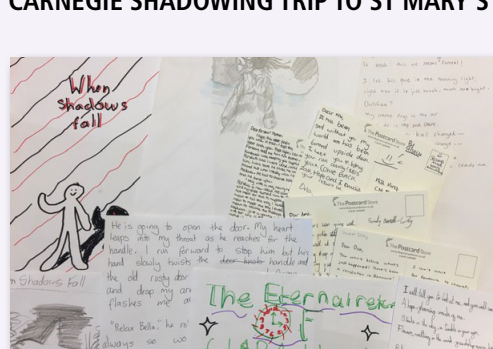
