# ▶ A MESSAGE FROM THE SENIOR PREFECT LEADERSHIP TEAM

As the new Senior Prefect Leadership Team we wanted to try and help support our local community this Christmas. We came up with the idea of a reverse advent calendar. The way that would work is on the days leading up to the end of term, two students from each form (one for sixth form

groups) per day would bring in a few items (see list below) and at the end of Hockerill's mini advent, we will donate these items to the Bishop's Stortford food bank. Each form will receive a sign-up sheet where the child will be allocated a day. We would be very grateful if you could remind your children on this day to bring in an item of food.

The advent calendar will start on the Monday 30th November and last until the Tuesday 8th December. We will ask someone from each form to bring all the items their form has collected to the Refectory, where they will leave on a table and return to their form, avoiding the mixture of bubbles. Due to the current lockdown in England, we understand that boarders cannot leave the boarding houses to potentially get an item to donate. If all goes accordingly and the lockdown

is extended, we hope the form tutors can arrange accordingly so that they can bring in their items in the last week of term. However, if this is still difficult a couple of pounds or spare change would be appreciated. Suitable food that can be donated includes:

- Fruit juice
- The Bishop's Stortford food bank also says they need certain non-food items such as: toiletries (deodorant, toilet paper,

shower gel, shampoo, soap, tooth brushes, tooth paste, hand wipes), household items (laundry liquid detergent, laundry powder, washing up liquid), feminine products (sanitary towels and tampons), baby supplies (nappies, baby wipes and baby food). Once again thank you for any help you give, and we hope everyone has a good Christmas.

**Thursday** – Upper College and Sixth Form (Years 10 - 13)


